Appellation: Saint Emilion Grand Cru

Soils: Gravels

Grape varieties: 80% Merlot; 10% Cabernet Sauvignon ; 10% Cabernet Franc

Average age of the vineyard : 45 years

Winemaking process:

The techniques that have been used for several years are being continued and refined: grassing every other row, parcel selection, manual leaf thinning, green harvesting, sorting of grapes in the vineyard and in the cellar. The vineyards are managed in accordance with the principles of high environmental value agriculture.

Traditional winemaking.

Tasting notes:

The colour is a sublime red with violet highlights and an intense nose of black fruit mixed with hints of truffles. The wine is beautifully structured on the palate, with fine, elegant tannins. The body is particularly dense and expresses itself well over a long period, finishing with a lovely aromatic aftertaste of ripe fruit.

Wine pairing:

At 14 to 16°C after 2 hours' aeration, it is the perfect accompaniment to meat (beef, duck, pigeon, lamb, game, etc.), blue-veined cheeses and dark chocolate desserts.

Ageing capacity :

7 to 10 years
