

# LOW ALCOHOL WINE

## **VIN DE FRANCE**

MERLOT - MALBEC 2023

#### **Presentation:**

Château Les Bertrands is the flagship of Vignobles Dubois, a family property for 10 generations. The vineyard covers 140 hectares.

### Vineyard:

Location: on the right bank of the Gironde

Soil: Gravel, coarse and fine sand, some clayey gravel.

Subsoil: clayey gravel

Grape varieties: 50% Merlot – 50% Malbec

#### Vinification:

Mechanical harvest: At optimum maturity.

Fermentation: in thermo-regulated stainless steel vats.

Maturation: several months in vats. Reduction of alcohol by reverse osmosis.

## **Tasting notes:**

A fruity wine, with aromas of red and black fruit (raspberry, cherry). Round, light and supple. Easy to drink

## Wine pairing:

Serve between 15° and 17° with white or red grilled meat and cheese. Perfect as an aperitif, for a barbecue or a picnic.

### **Ageing capacity**

3 to 4 years
